Who Can Apply?

- Contribute to discussions on AI policy, ethics and responsible technology governance.
- Develop policy briefs, student manifestos and evidence-based ideas on AI governance.
- Participate in opportunities such as conferences, policy hackathons, webinars, workshops and international dialogues.
- Promote AI literacy and ethical technology practices within the university community.
- Access strategic guidance, frameworks, mentorship and peer-learning opportunities.
